**Principal News:** (Cathi Poplar)

Term 1 report card data

- Literacy: on par with district numbers
- Math: on par with district numbers

SIP: (Cathi Poplar/Sandra Kitchen)

- Goals have remained the same except for math which is more defined to respond to needs of MV students: teachers have noticed that the learning students are demonstrating during math talks is not translating through when producing written work. Teachers have implemented exit tickets for students to complete to provide more practice as well as providing another avenue for assessing learning. Goal is to have 60% of students reaching mastery

### School updates:

- School applied for and received outdoor learning grant: benches are being installed in the gazebo, a rain water collection system will be used to help in the tending of gardening beds that are planning to be built. Looking at getting tree signage in the woods behind the school to identify different types of trees. Money will also be used to update gravel at the back of the school. Some disc golf holes have been purchased, and the school is partnering with the district to see about designing a disc golf course that could be used by the community.
- Centers of excellence (EECD) treated the school to a day of STEM activities as well as razzmatazz and remi bilingual shows.
- A new casual school custodian (2hr) has been added due to the increased space added by the art and resource hub that opened in December.
- 141 students are currently registered and 18 K's for the next school year (expected to be more)
