A thermos is a great way to send your child's hot lunch. Fill it with boiling water for 10 minutes and then put in their piping hot food and it will be warm at lunch time. Children are unable to use microwaves.

School Hours

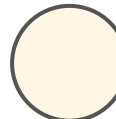
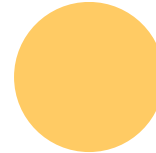


Students **should not arrive at school prior to 7:45 a.m.** as teachers do not begin to supervise until this time.

Sleep and Screens

Sleep

Sleep is very important to help regulate our students as these days will seem long to many in September. Sleep helps with mood regulation, behaviour, and memory consolidation and learning cognitive ability

Age appropriate sleep for age 4 and 5 is
9-11 hours a night

Screen time

Screens can be entertaining and educational however please consider limiting screen time to 1 hour of less per day and be cautious of screen 1 hour before bedtime

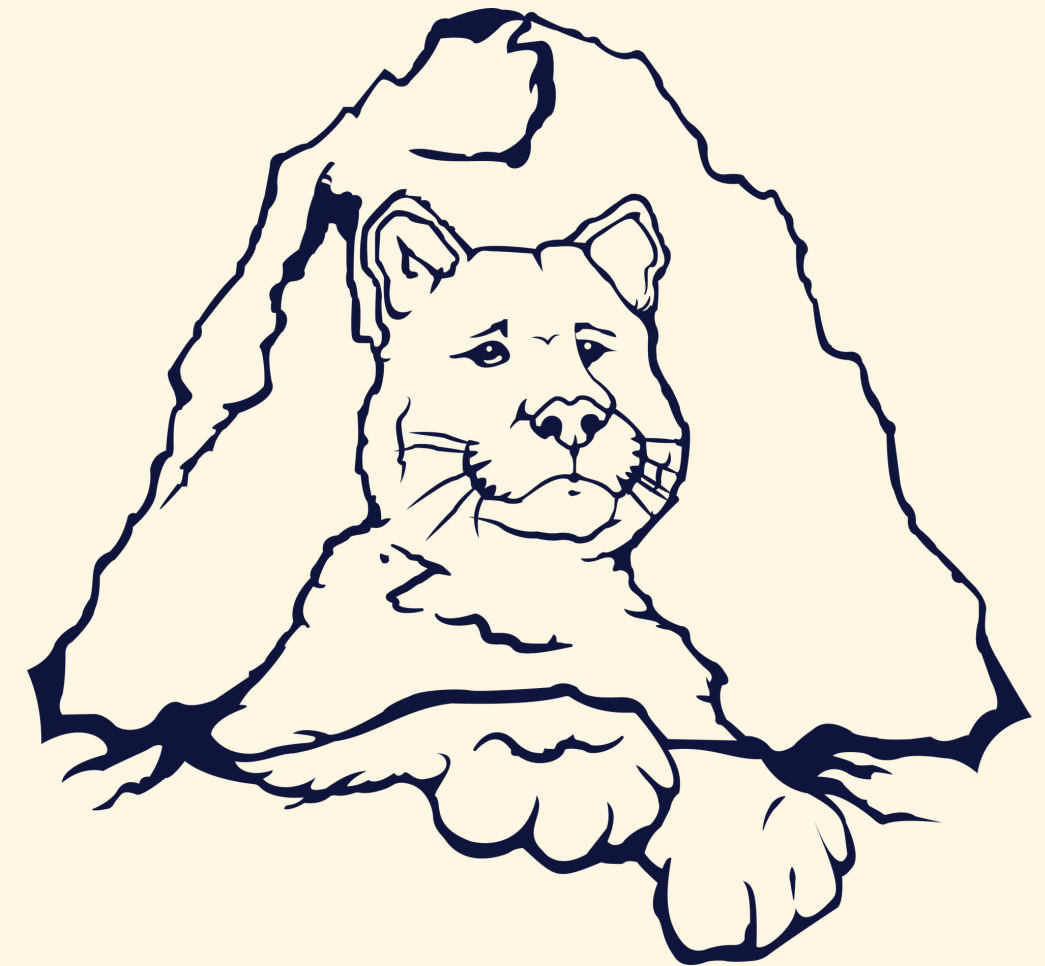
